Time and Place

The 13th International Chess Festival "Riga Technical University Open" 2024 (hereafter referred to as the Festival) is scheduled to be held from **August 3rd to August 11th** at the **International Exhibition Center "Kipsala"** (Ķīpsalas iela 8, Riga, Latvia, LV-1048). This center stands as the largest specialized exhibition center in the Baltic states, offering a spacious hall spanning 5700 square meters, ensuring best possible conditions for chess.

The total prize fund is planned to be **29 000 EUR** for all tournaments.


The prize pool for each tournament is determined by the number of participants. The detailed prize breakdown for each tournament will be verified during the festival.

1. 100 vs. 100 Team Tournament

Team tournament on 100 boards between teams of LAT, LTU, EST, and the Rest of World

<u>Regulations</u>: Round Robin, 3 rounds.

<u>Time limit</u>: 10 minutes per game per player + 5 seconds per move starting from the first move. Schedule:



2. Latvian Chess Federation & FIDE 100-Year Anniversary Blitz Tournament

Open Blitz Tournament Dedicated to the 100-Year Anniversary of FIDE and the LCF

Regulations: Swiss system, 11 rounds, FIDE rules, ELO rated.

The tournament's prize fund is set to be **1,200 EUR**, guaranteed if there are at least 100 participants. The first prize is a guaranteed **170 EUR**. There will be 8 general prizes and special prizes for the three best women, three best juniors (born 2006 and later), and three best senior players (born 1963 and earlier) as well as prizes in three different rating groups.

Prizes are not shared, and a player can only receive one prize.

Financial prizes

The tournament's prize fund is set to be **2,000 EUR**, guaranteed if there are at least 100 participants. The first prize is a guaranteed **350 EUR**. There will be 8 general prizes and special prizes for the three best women, three best juniors (born 2006 and later), and three best senior players (born 1963 and earlier) as well as prizes in four different rating groups.

Prizes are not shared, and a player can only receive one prize.

4. Tournament A – Grandmaster Open

Open tournament with GM, IM, WGM, and WIM title norms

Regulations: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules, ELO rated.

Discounts

FMs, WFMs, juniors up to 18 years of age (born 2006 and later), seniors over 65 years of age (born 1959 and earlier) have a **25 % discount**.

Players representing Latvian Chess Federation have a **35% discount**.

FMs, WFMs, juniors up to 18 years of age and seniors over 65 years who represents Latvian Chess Federation have a **50% discount**.

Discounts do not add up. This discount does not refer to the additional charge for late registration.

Financial prizes

The tournament's prize fund is set to be **20,000 EUR**, guaranteed if there are at least 200 participants. The first prize is a guaranteed **3,000 EUR**. There will be 20 general prizes and special prizes for the four best women, three best juniors (born 2006 and later), and four best senior players (born 1963 and earlier) as well as prizes in four different rating groups.

General prizes are shared using the Hort system, special prizes are not shared. A player can receive only one prize.

5. Tournament B – Amateur Open (ELO < 2200)

Open tournament for players with ELO rating up to 2199

Regulations: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules, ELO rated.

<u>Time limit</u>: 90 minutes per game per player + 30 seconds per move starting from the first move.

Schedule: The same as for Tournament A.

Juniors up to 18 years of age (born 2006 and later) and seniors over 65 years of age (born 1959 and earlier) have a **25% discount**.

This discount does not discount does not apply to the additional fee for late registration.

Financial prizes

The tournament's prize fund is set to be **1,800 EUR**, guaranteed if there are at least 70 participants. The first prize is a guaranteed **250 EUR**. There will be 8 general prizes and special prizes for the three best women, three best juniors (born 2006 and later), and three best senior players (born 1963 and earlier) as well as prizes in three different rating groups.

Prizes are not shared, and a player can only receive one prize.

6. Tournament C – Weekend Amateur Open (ELO < 2400)

The tournament's prize fund is set to be **1,500 EUR**, guaranteed if there are at least 50 participants. The first prize is a guaranteed **190 EUR**. There will be 8 general prizes and special prizes for the three best women, three best juniors (born 2006 and later), and three best senior players (born 1963 and earlier) as well as prizes in two different rating groups.

Prizes are not shared, and a player can only receive one prize.

7. Tournament D – Weekend Amateur Open (ELO < 1800)

The tournament's prize fund is set to be **1,200 EUR**, guaranteed if there are at least 100 participants. The first prize is a guaranteed **170 EUR**. There will be 8 general prizes and special prizes for the three best women, three best juniors (born 2006 and later), and three best senior players (born 1963 and earlier) as well as prizes in three different rating groups.

Prizes are not shared, and a player can only receive one prize.

Entries

Early registrations (by specifying your Name, ELO, Date of Birth, Country, and accommodation if necessary) for the tournaments A - D should be sent before the **26th of July** either by e-mail: <u>chess@rtu.lv</u> or by filling out the application form on the official website of the festival <u>https://rtuopen.com/</u>. The **onsite registration** according to the schedule of the corresponding tournament **is mandatory** also for online pre-registered participants, including participants that have free entry. The organizers reserve the right to exclude players who have missed the onsite registration deadline from the tournament.

Players from the Russian Federation or the Republic of Belarus cannot participate in the festival, regardless of their status, including the so-called neutral athlete.

Late registration

Players whose application to tournaments A - D will be registered after the **26th of July** will pay an additional charge of 10 EUR.

Late arrival

The waiting time in Tournaments A - D in case of late arrival is 30 minutes.

Tie-breaks

In case of an equal number of points, the following tie-break criteria are used:

- a) Buchholz Cut 1;
- b) Buchholz;
- c) Rating Performance;
- d) Direct Encounter;
- e) Greater number of victories;
- f) Most games as black.

Prize giving

All players must be present at the closing ceremony to receive financial prizes. The organizers reserve the right not to pay out prizes if the participant fails to arrive.

Accommodation

Festival participants and guests can take advantage of **special rates** at the festival's official hotels. However, the number of rooms is limited, so reservations will be accepted on a first-come, firstserved basis. The prices listed below are guaranteed until the rooms reserved by the organizers are fully booked, or until the **26th of July**, whichever comes first.
